

**INVITATION OF COMMENTS ON THE PROPOSED REVISION OF MORD
STANDARD DATA BOOK FOR ANALYSIS OF RATES
FOR RURAL ROADS**

Concerns have been expressed from several quarters, including Consultants/Contractors and user agencies that Rate Analysis of some of the items of work in the MORD Standard Data Book for Analysis of Rates for Rural Roads, 2004 have outlived their relevance and thus require necessary amendments/modifications based on experience gained in use of MORD Standard Data Book since 2004 as also in view of revision of MORD Specifications.

Accordingly, National Rural Roads Development Agency, Ministry of Rural Development has entrusted the work of Revision of the MORD Standard Data Book to IRC in the light of Indian conditions. This is to incorporate the changes in Project Size, use of latest machinery and equipment as well as experience gained in construction of Rural Roads under PMGSY and also considering revision of MORD Specifications, 2004 in the near future.
